



Another pleasing trade was seen for all types of store lambs at Broughton, with new & local vendors all leaving with a smile on their faces. 880 lambs were forward and many more could have been sold.

The sale topped at £113 twice for texels from JE&WB Wearing, Low Shaw and Miss S Thompson, Moss Side Farm, with a full ringfull from Mr S Wood, Hawkshead selling to £110. Suffolk lambs sold to £108 from JE&WB Wearing, Low Shaw, a lovely run of Cheviot lambs from J Angus, High Ground sold to a pen of £95 for a pen of 30. Texel x Herdwicks lambs were in strong demand with the best selling to £97 also from J Angus, High Ground, with the nicer ones making £80 - £85. An overall average of £91.67 was achieved with many longer keep lambs in this run.
